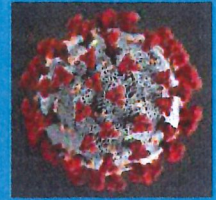

As COVID-19 continues to escalate, I know there is a lot on your minds as volunteers, Habitat homeowners and community supporters. We anticipate daily updates from public health and other authorities, with continued advisement of recommended precautions. With the risk of further spread of the disease, it is important for all of us at Habitat Brant-Norfolk to be good global citizens by doing what we can to slow down the spread of disease, so our health and services sectors are not overwhelmed. This is best for all of us.

As of March 13, 2020 our Volunteer shifts - including ReStore, Build and Committee Meetings - were suspended. The Board, CEO and our response team have reviewed our current COVID-19 plans and assessed whether further adjustments are warranted. While at the moment, no shut down of non-essential operations has been announced, for the sake of everyone's continued safety.....

As of today, we have made a decision to close all Habitat Brant-Norfolk work-sites -- office, ReStores, and build sites – through to March 31, 2020.

We will reassess the situation in the days ahead to determine next steps and we will continue to provide updates when we are able to. We commit to communicating with you, our Habitat family and community, regularly during this period of uncertainty to keep you updated on Habitat Brant-Norfolk's operational plans. While we may be physically distancing ourselves for now, we look forward to seeing you all again soon, when it's safe to do so.
